Some examples of these documents are included here.

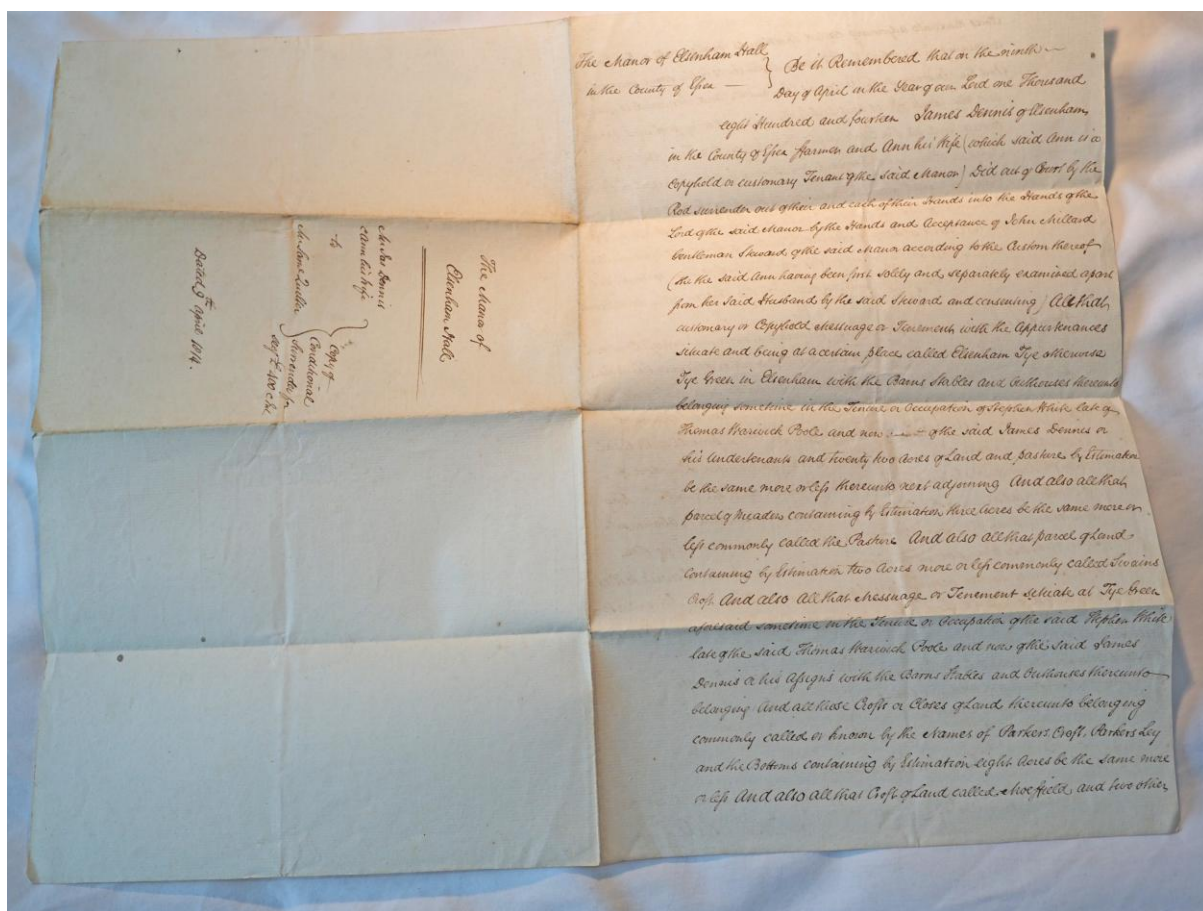
Please Note:

Many of these documents are of a very large format and in order to obtain a copy of them photography was used to capture one page per image.

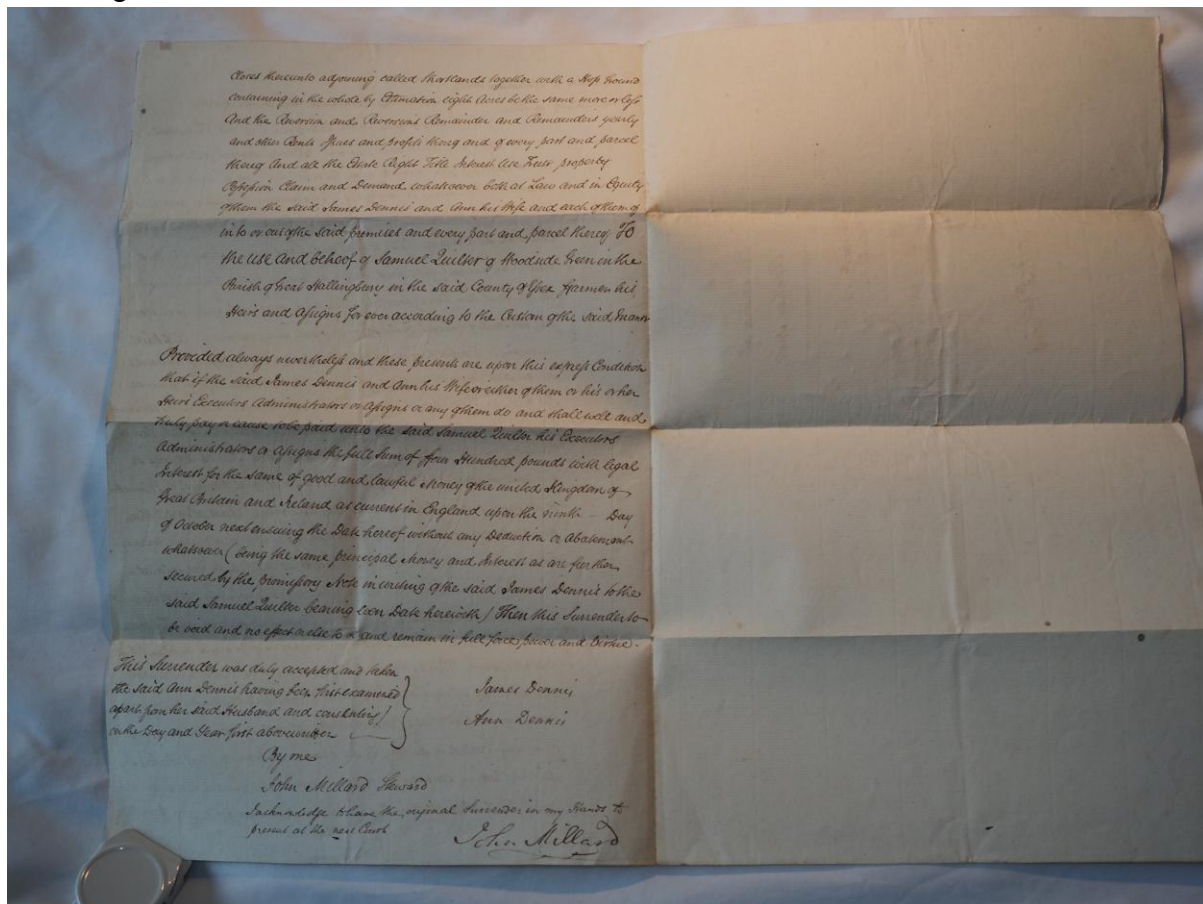

The amount of effort that went in to the handwritten versions can only be imagined.

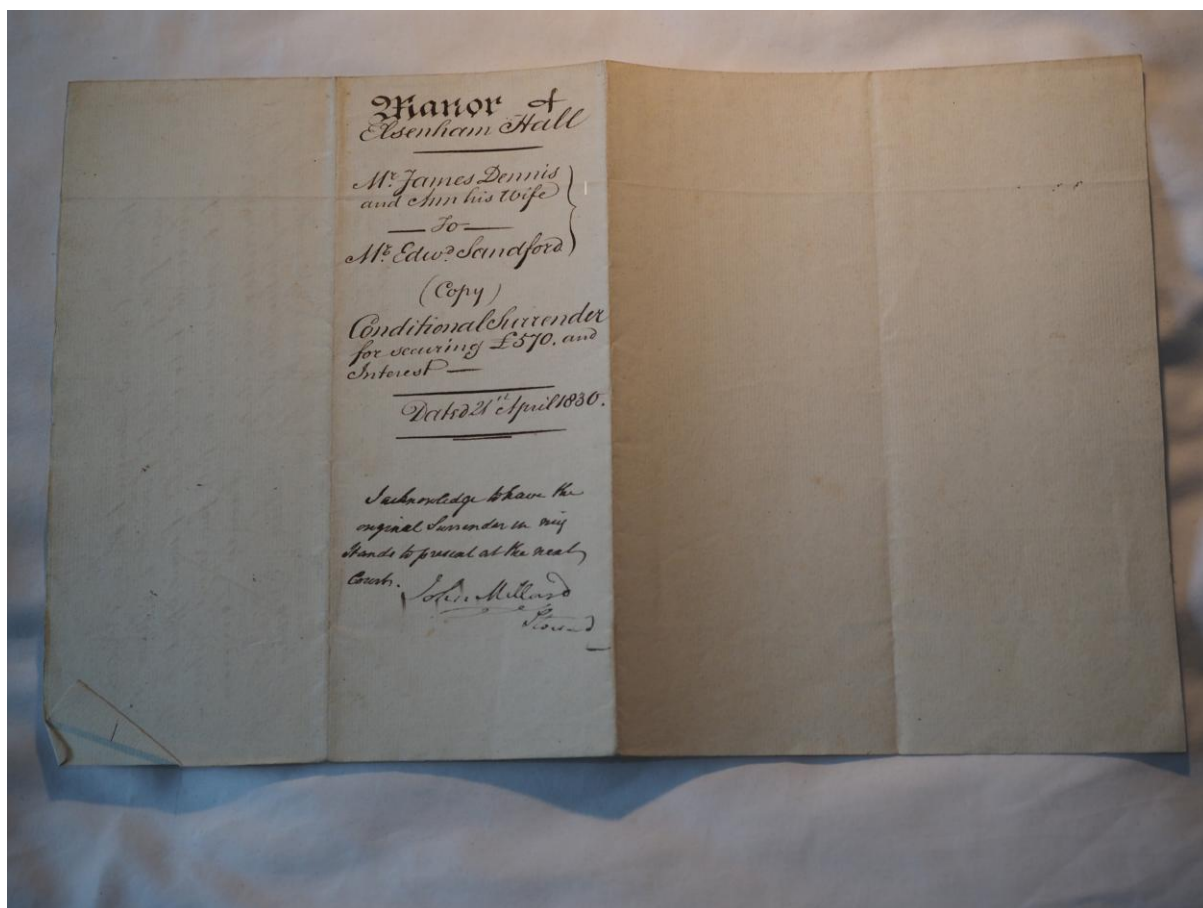

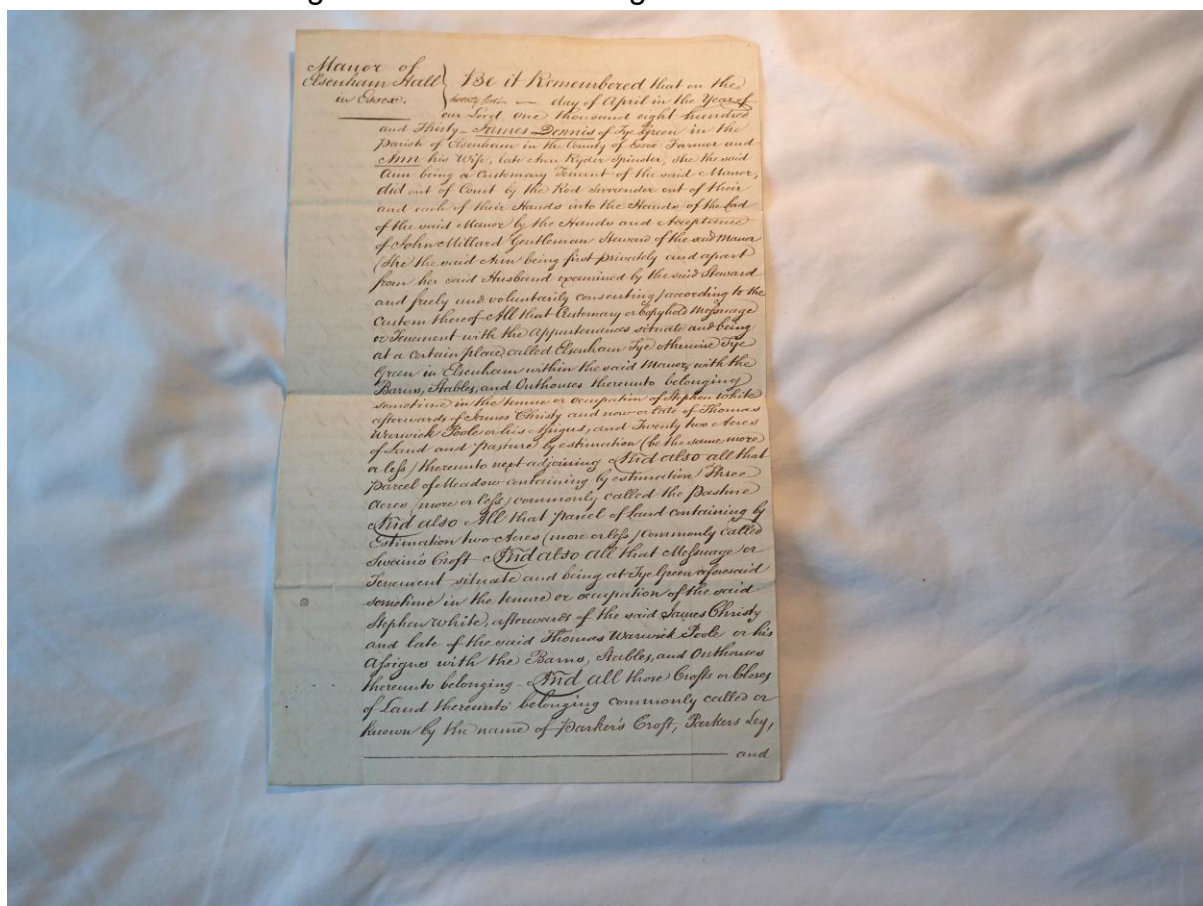
9th April 1814 Copy of conditional surrender for £400 By Mr James Dennis and his wife Page 1



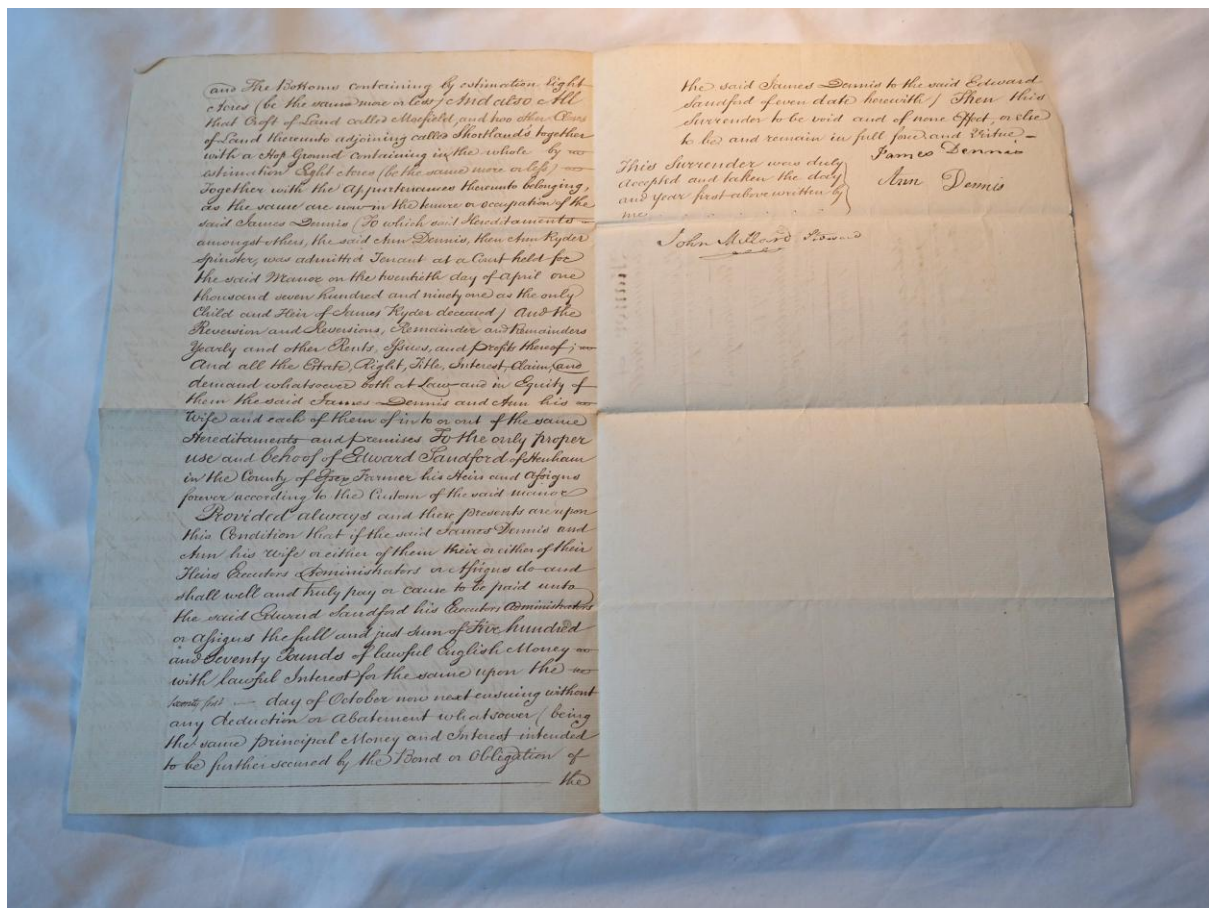
9th April 1814 Copy of conditional surrender for £400 By Mr James Dennis and his wife Page 2



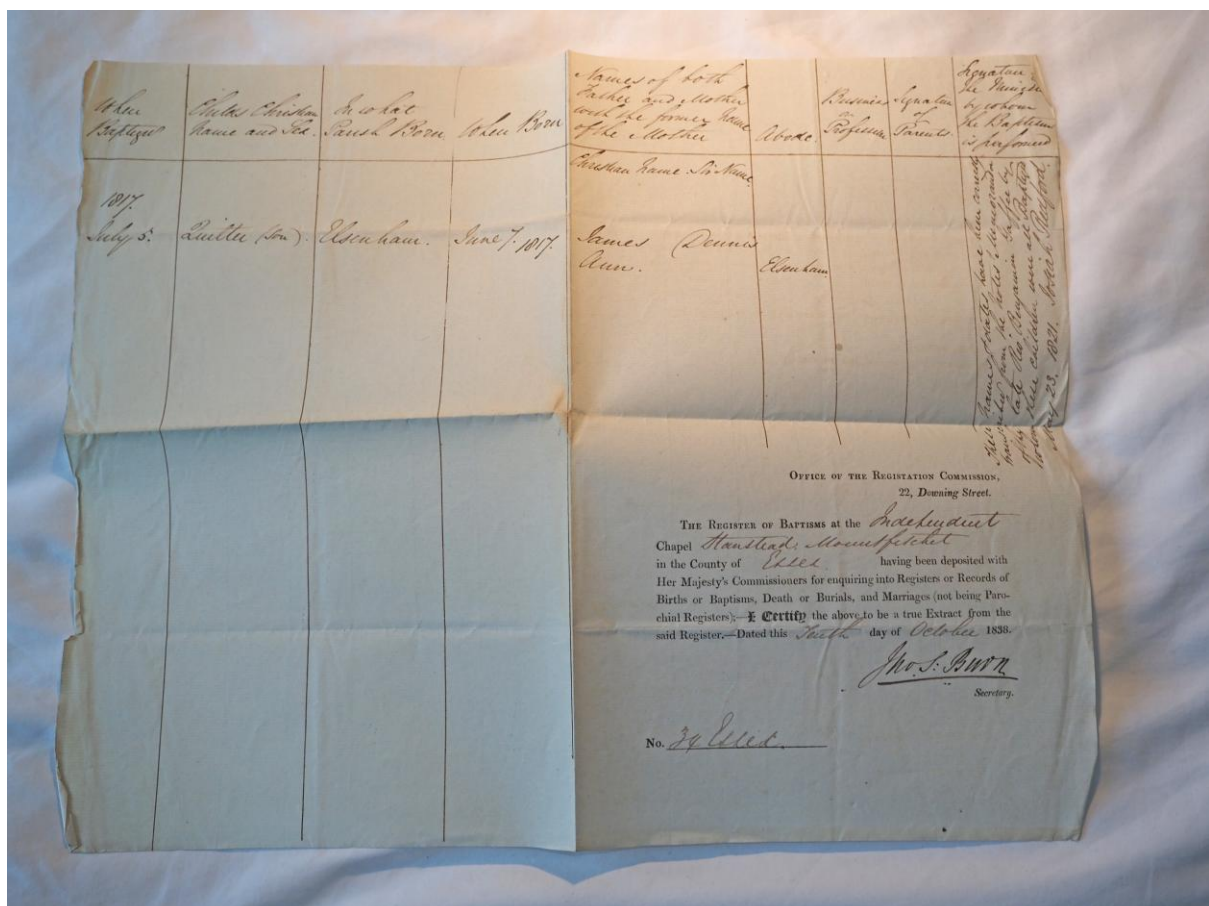
21st April 1830 James Dennis and his wife Ann to Edward Sanford conditional Surrender for securing £570 and interest Page 1



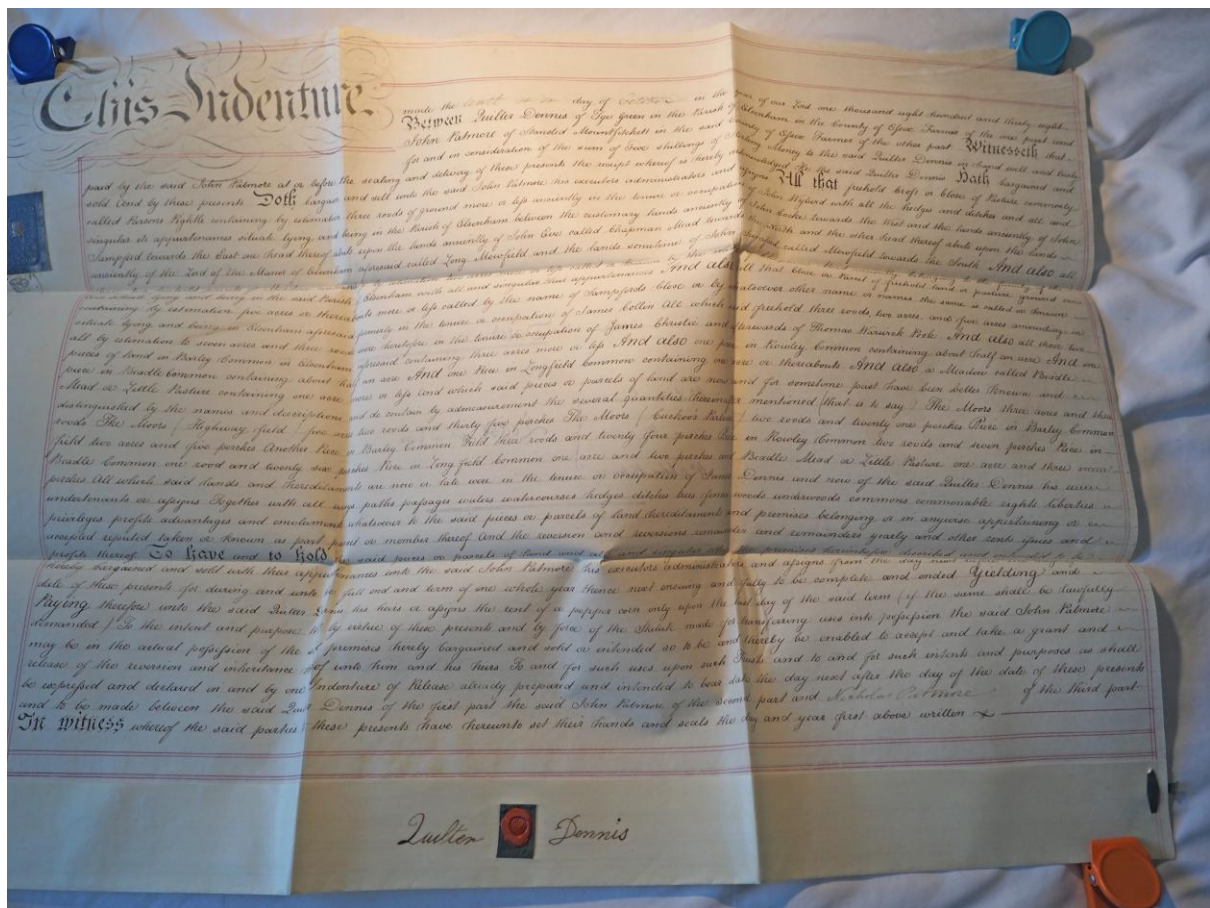
21st April 1830 James Dennis and his wife Ann to Edward Sanford conditional Surrender for securing £570 and interest Page 2



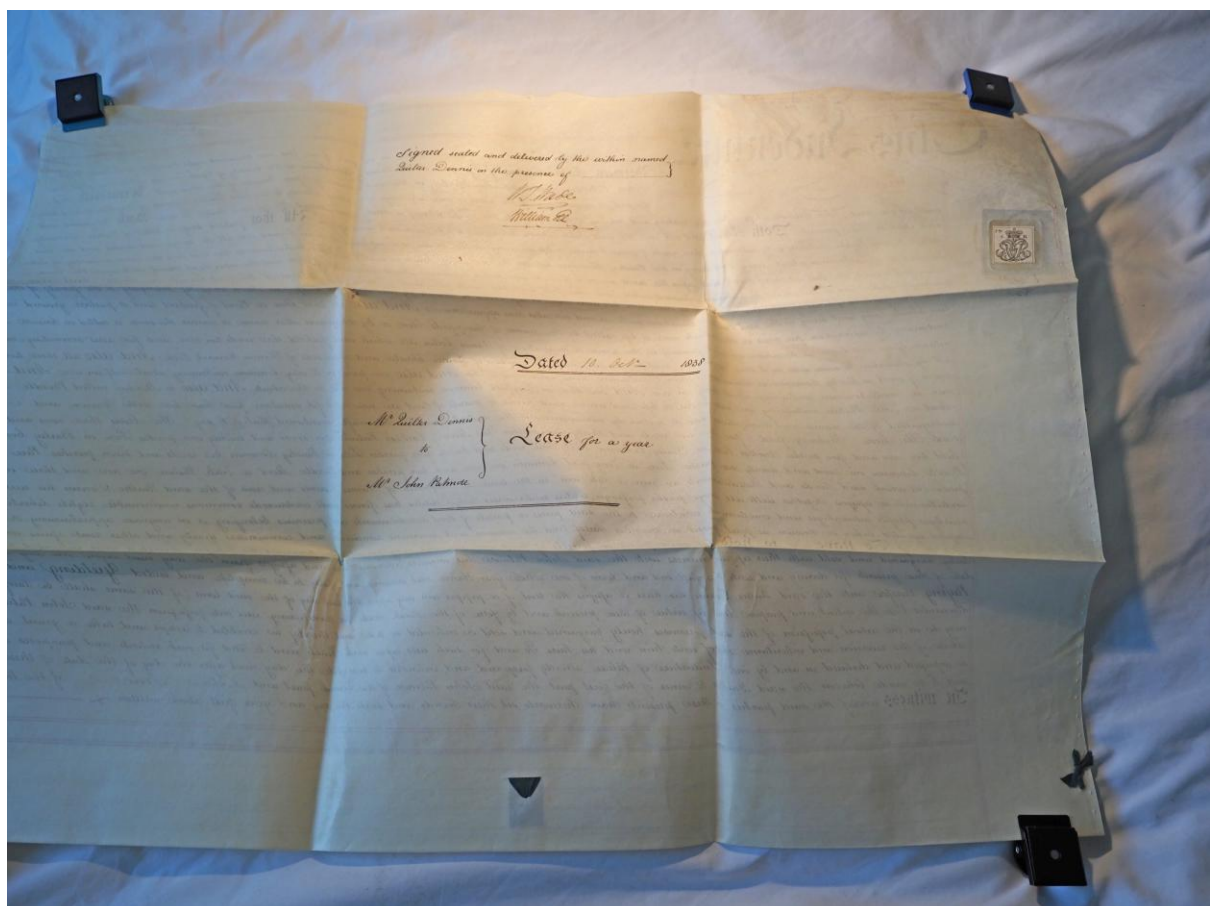
21st April 1830 James Dennis and his wife Ann to Edward Sandford conditional Surrender for securing £570 and interest Page 3



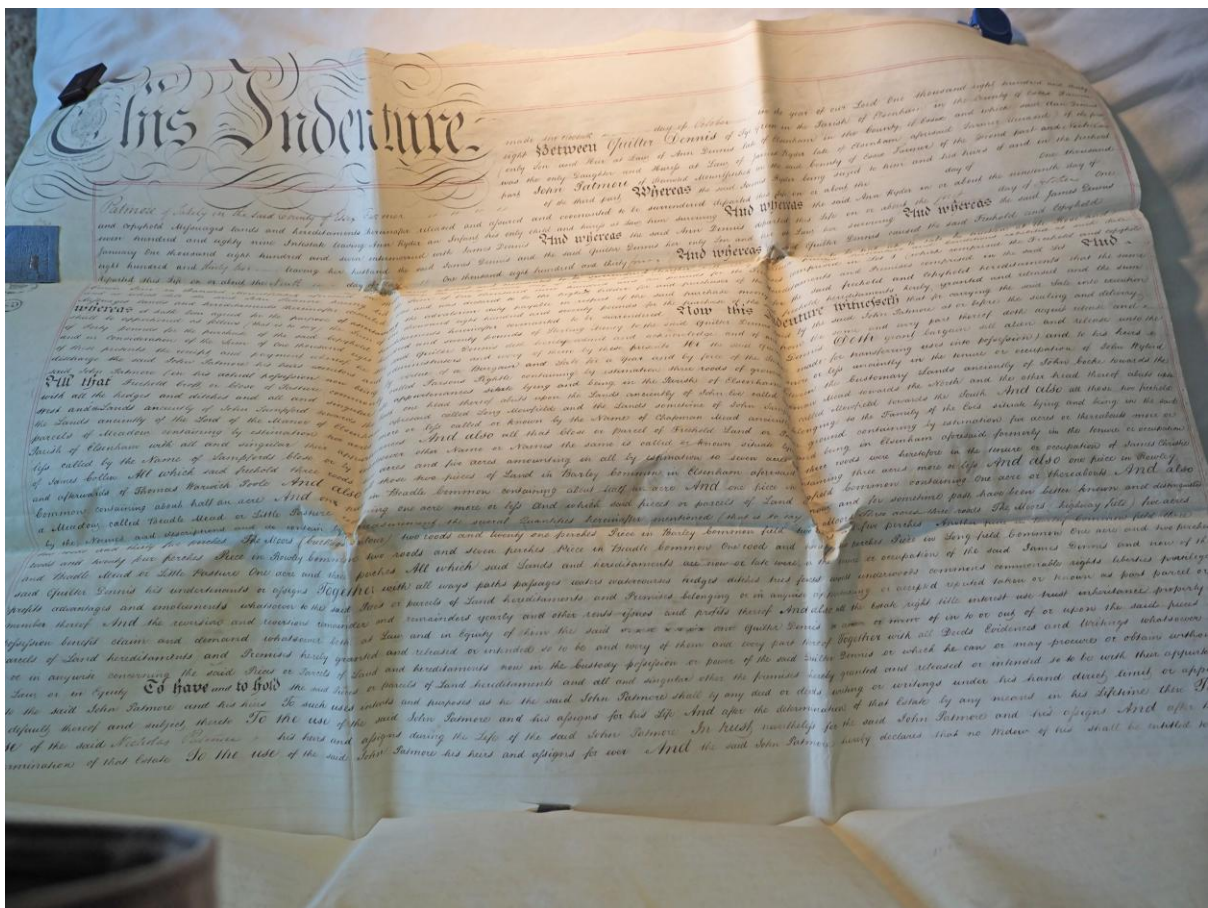
10th October 1838 Copy of Registration of Birth Quilter Dennis date of birth 7th June 1817



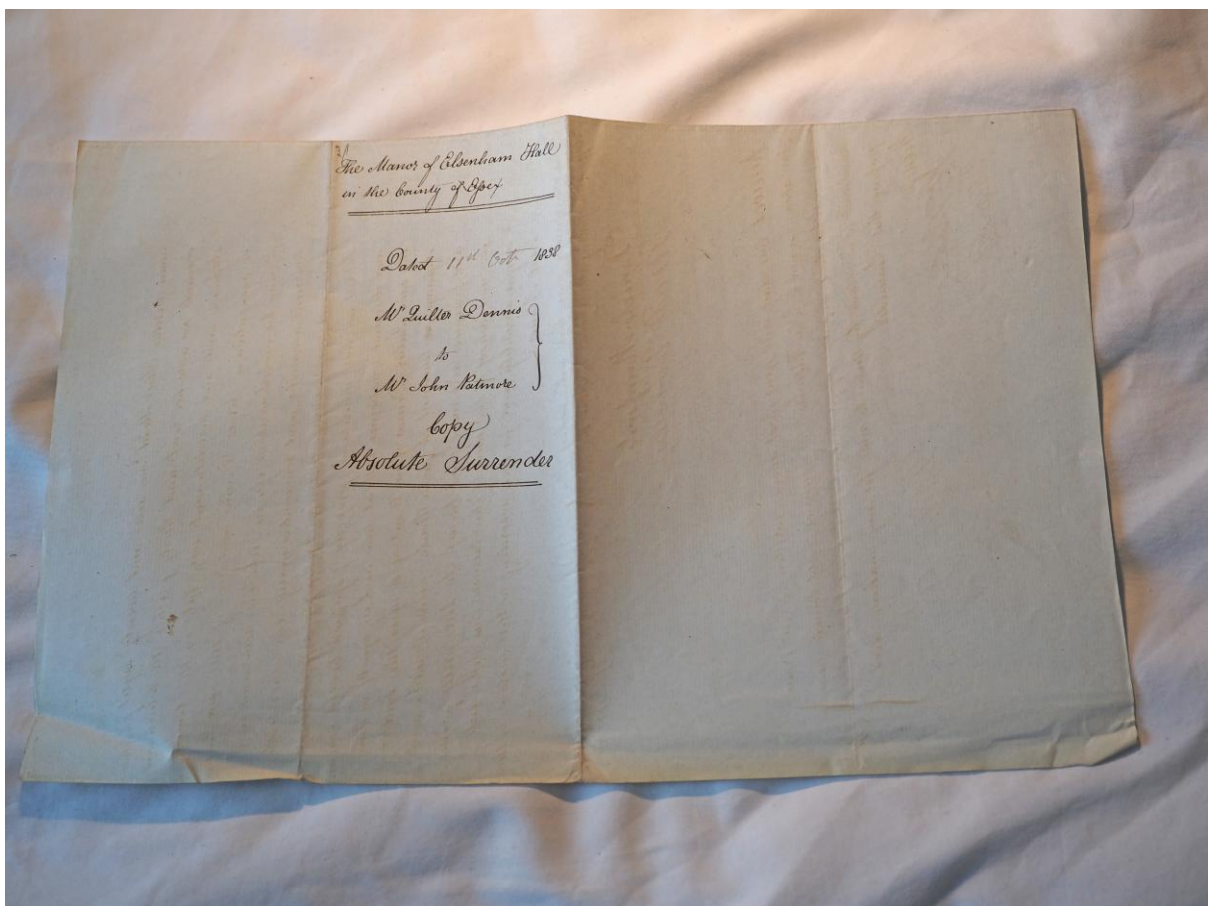
10th October 1838 Indenture Quilter Dennis and John Patmore



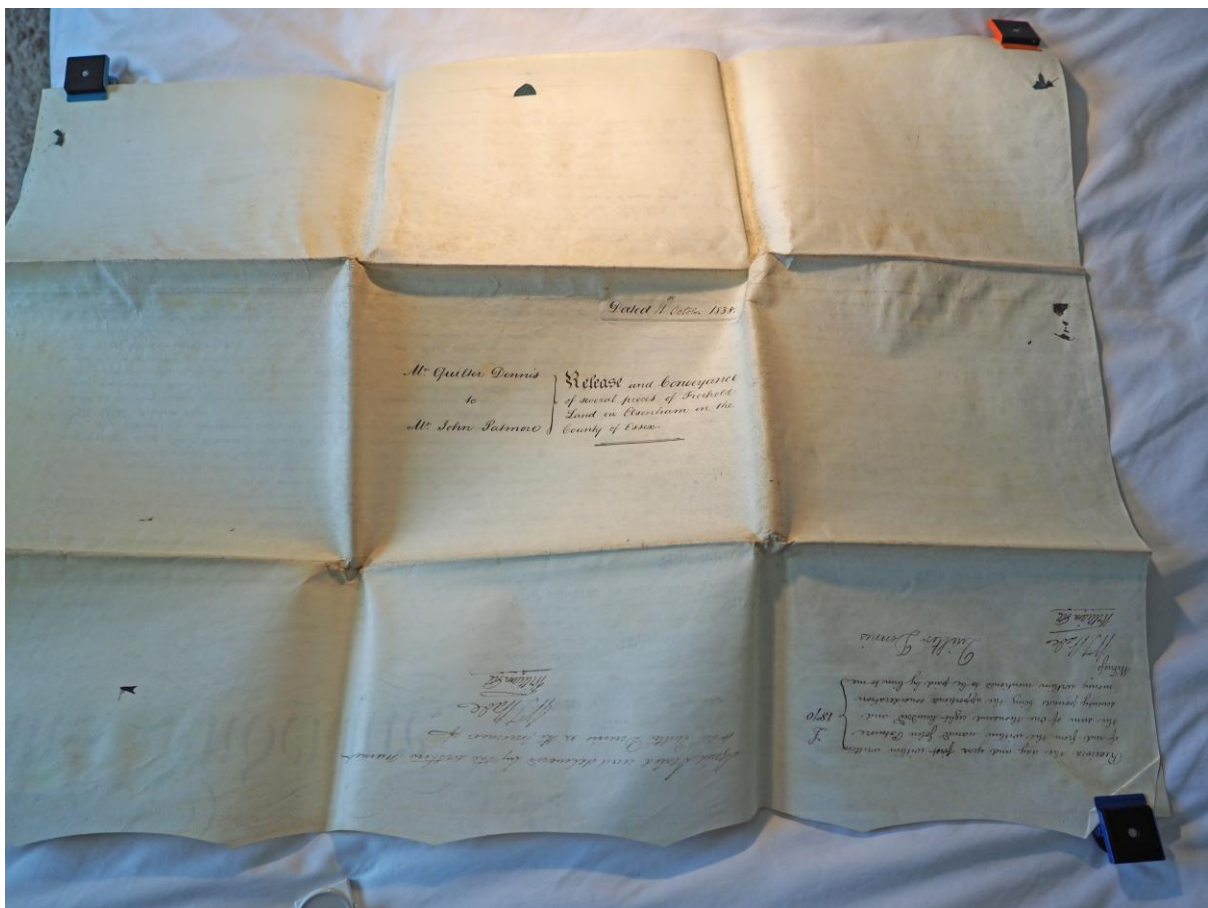

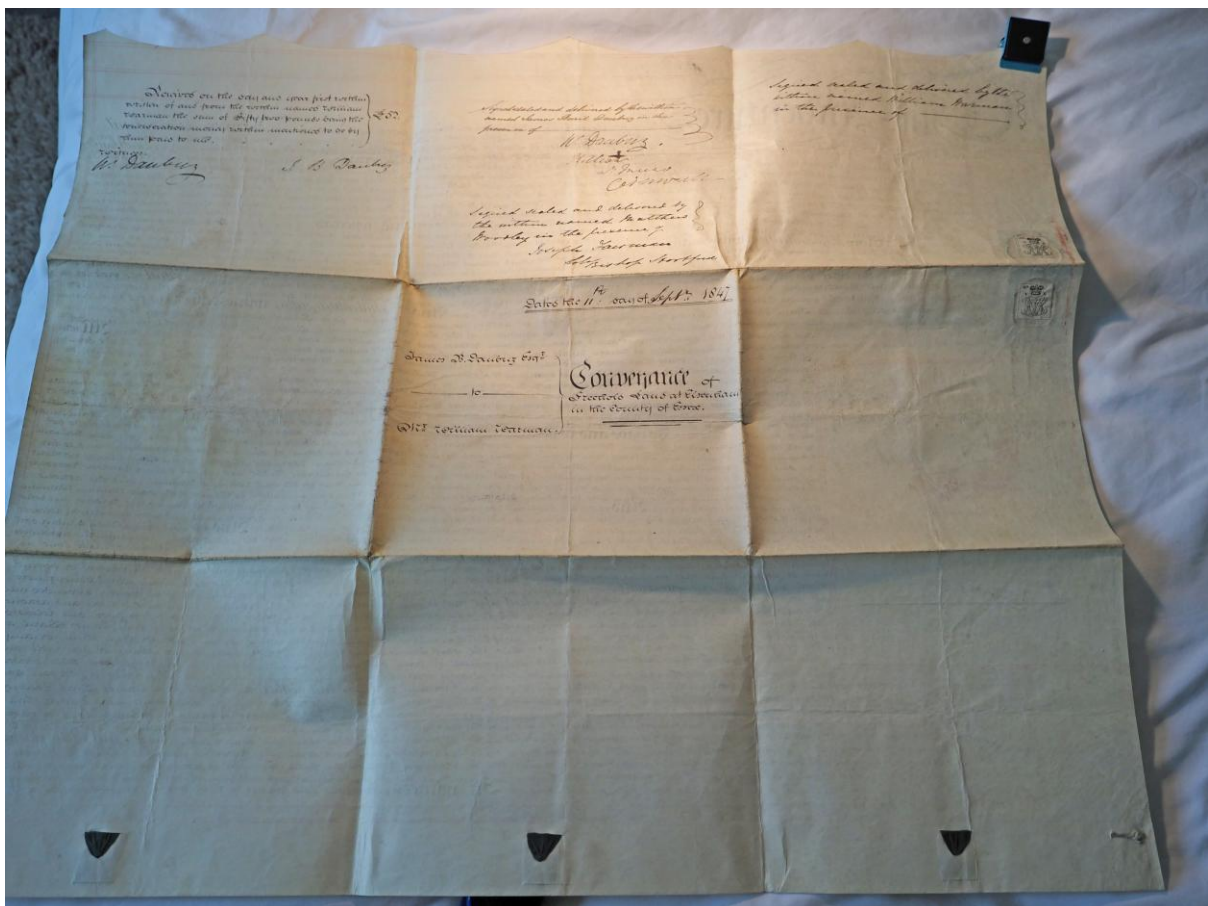
11th October 1838 Indenture Quilter Dennis and John Patmore



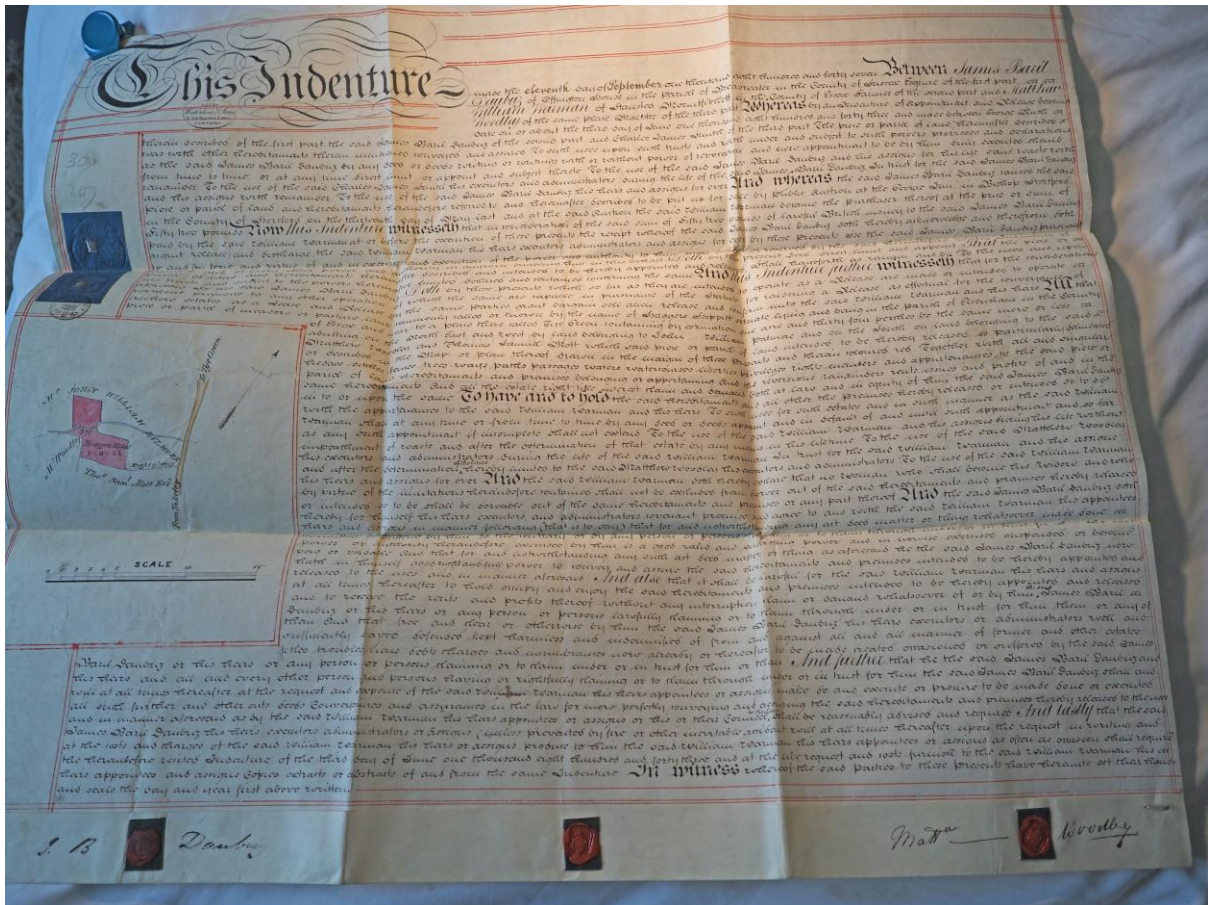
11th October 1838 Quilter Dennis to John Patmore Copy Absolute Surrender



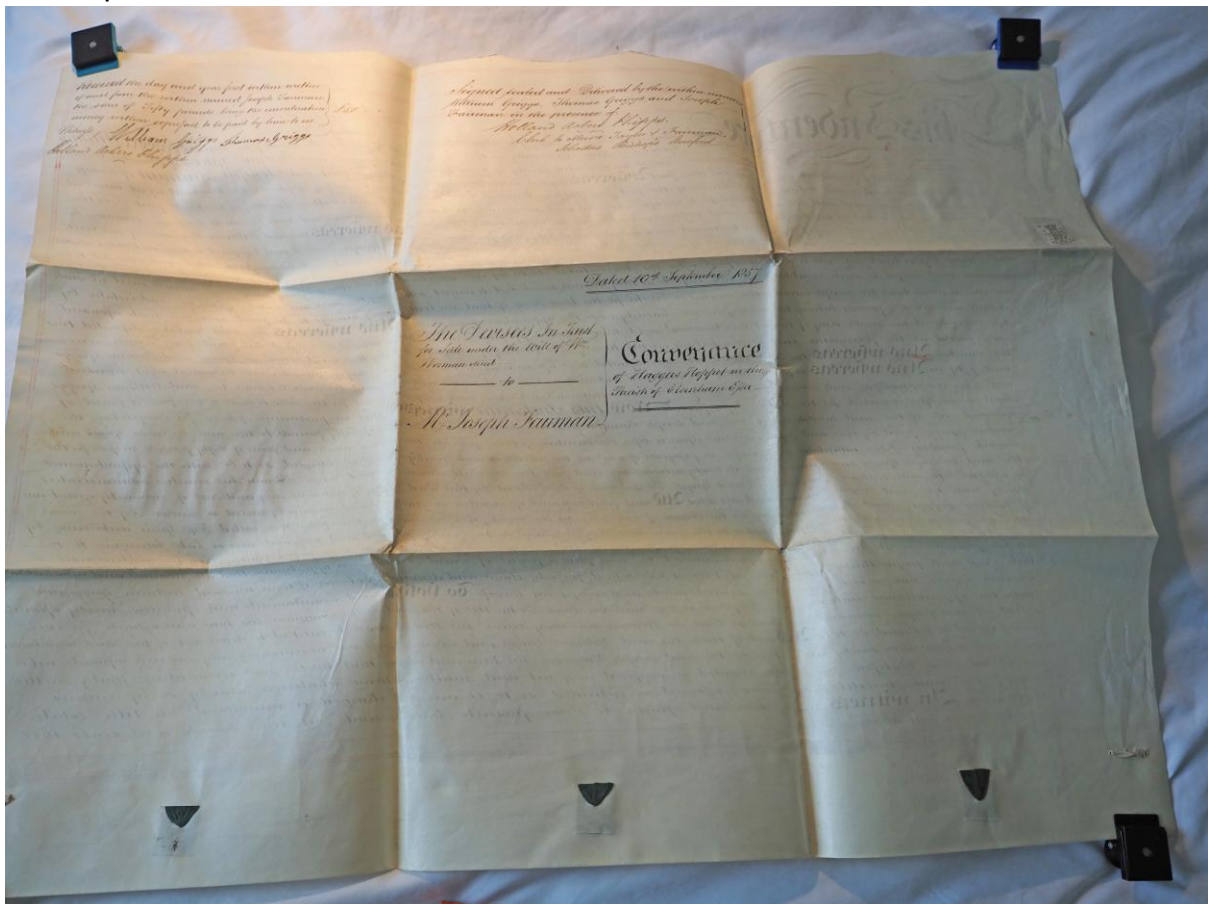
11th October 1838 Release and Conveyance John Patmore Quiller Dennis



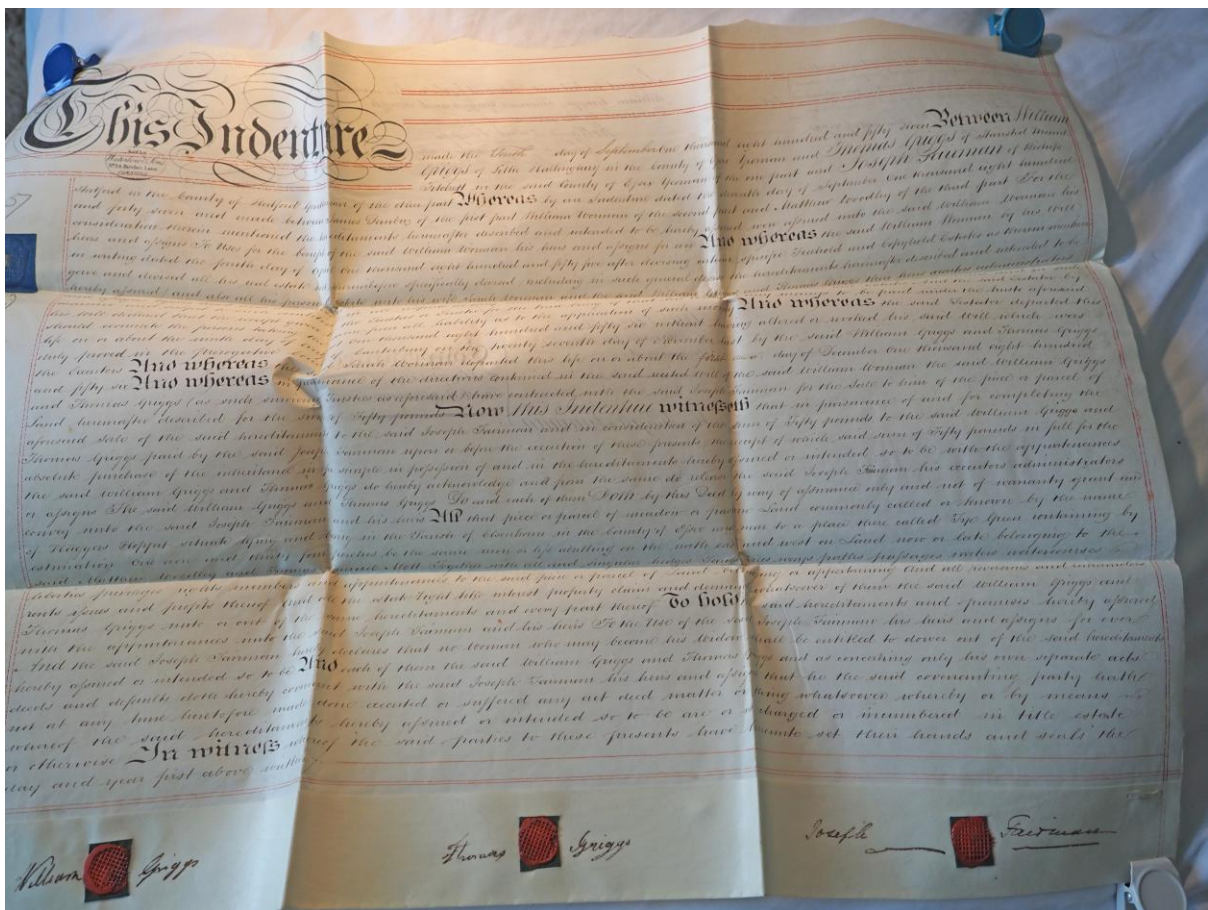
11th September 1847 Conveyance James Daubuz to William Harman



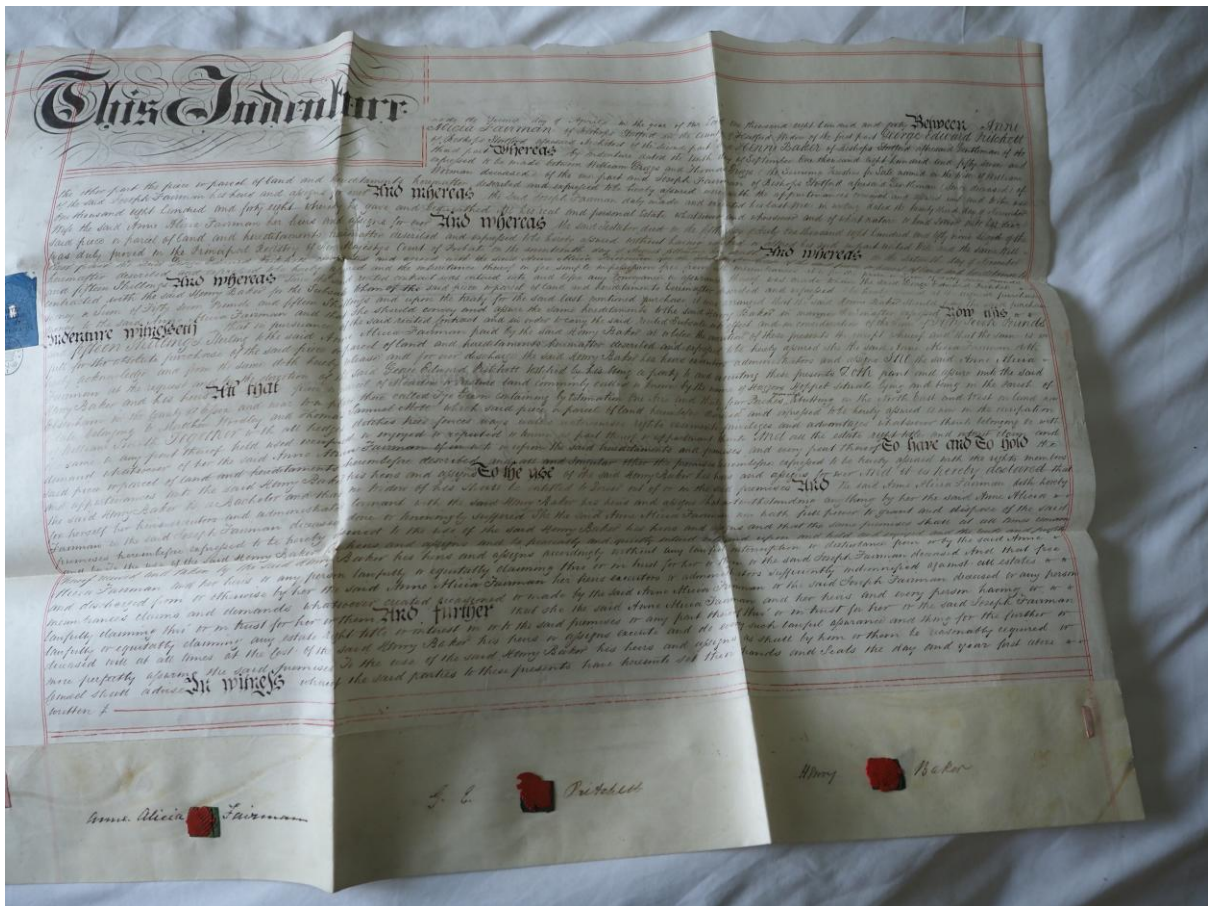
11th September 1847 Indenture James Daubuz to William Harman



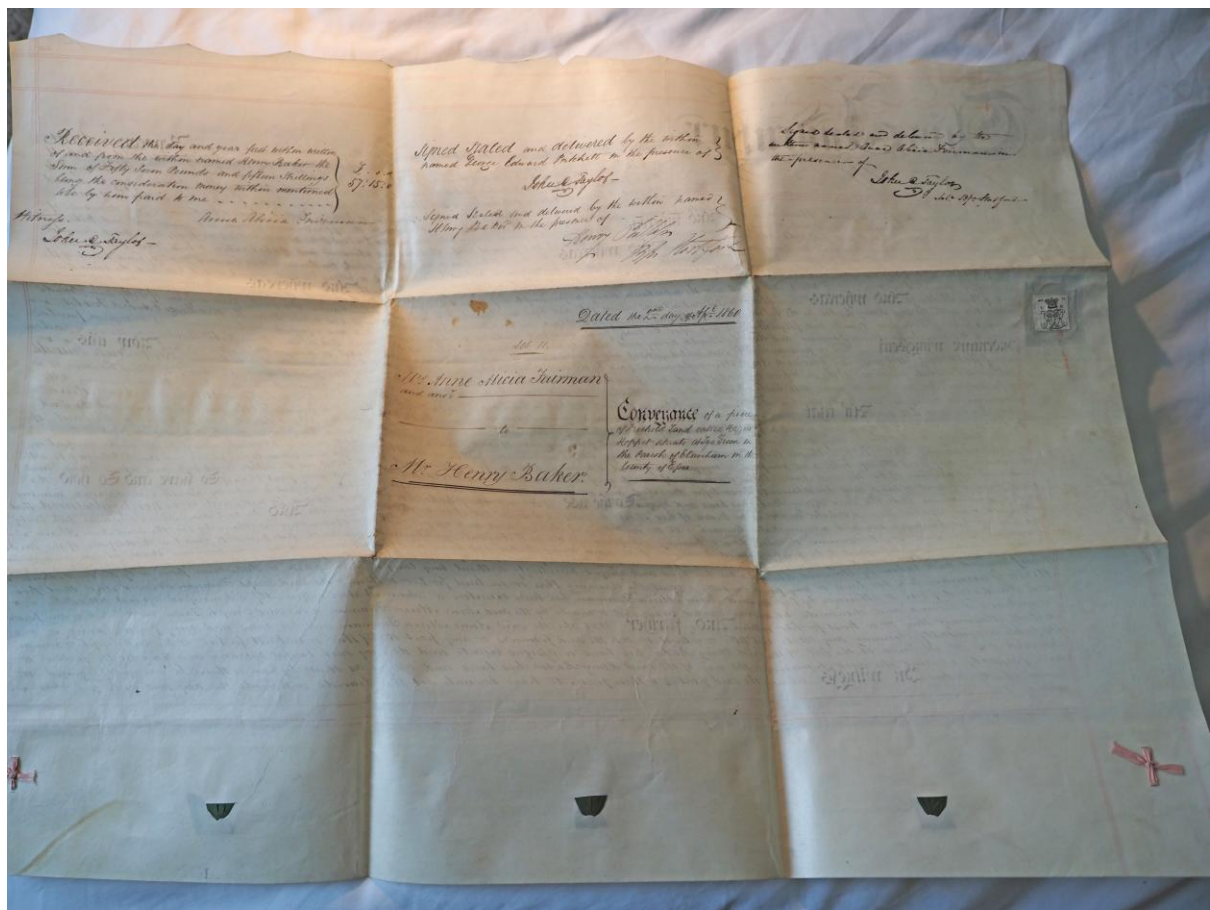
10th September 1857 Conveyance to Joseph Fairman



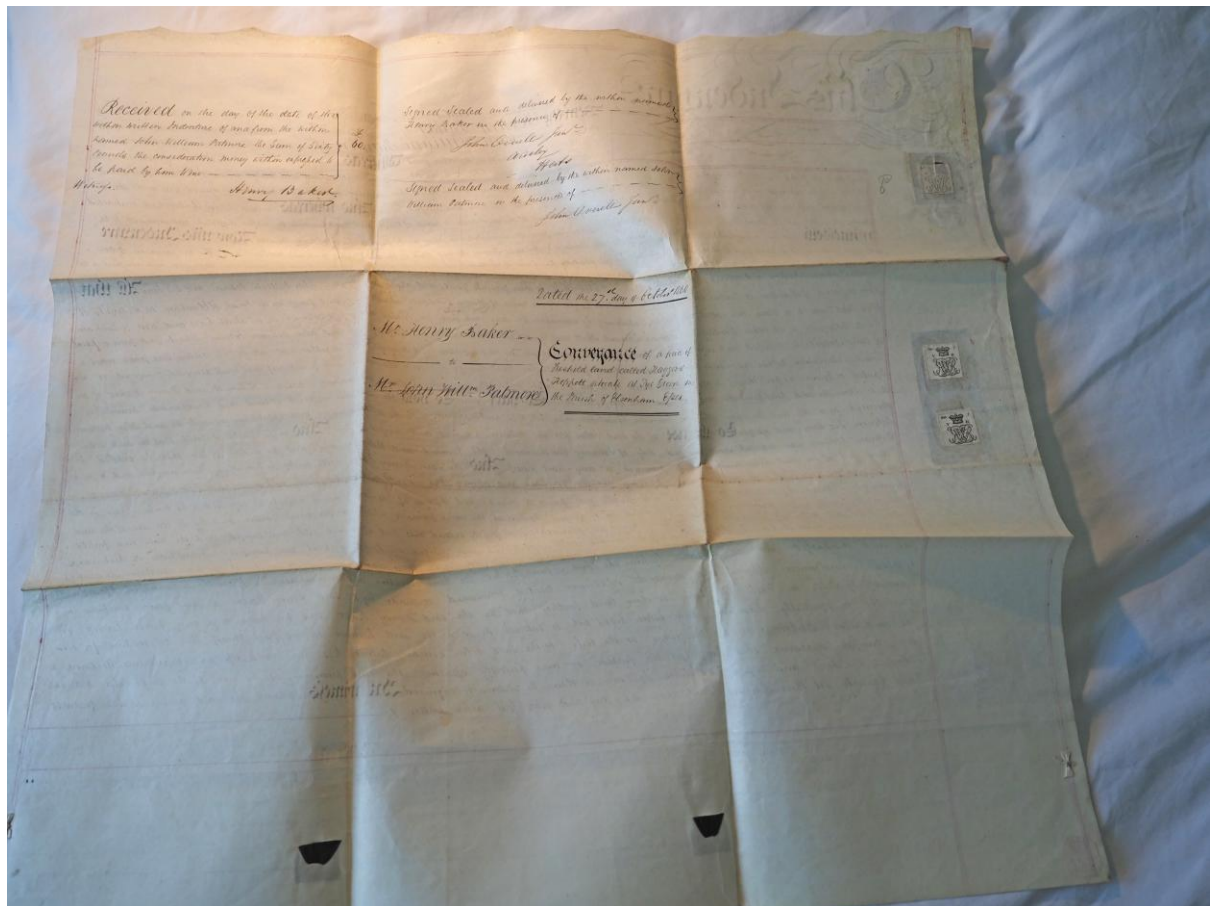
10th September 1857 Indenture Griggs Farman



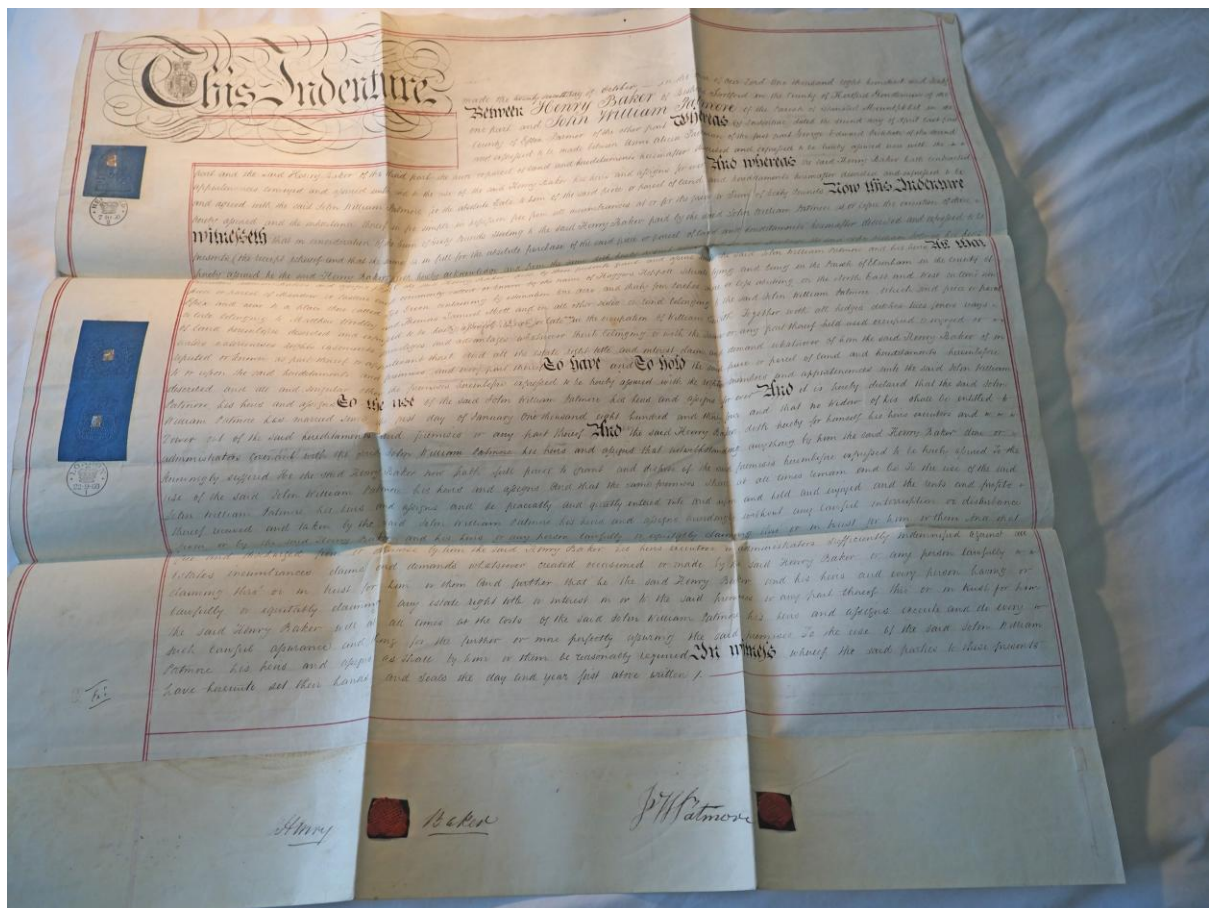
2nd April 1860 Indenture Anne Fairman and George Pritchett to Henry Baker



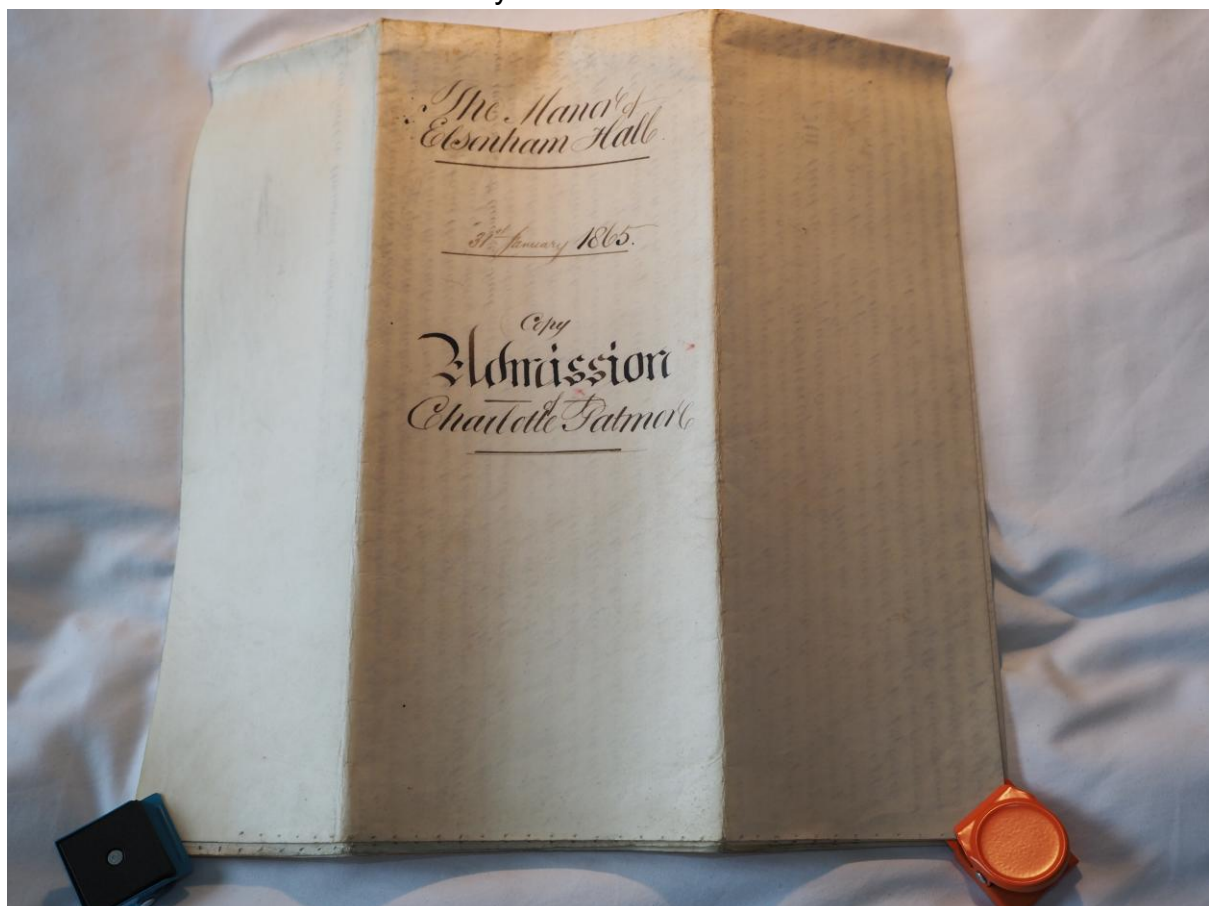
2nd April 1860 Indenture Cover Anne Fairman to Henry Baker



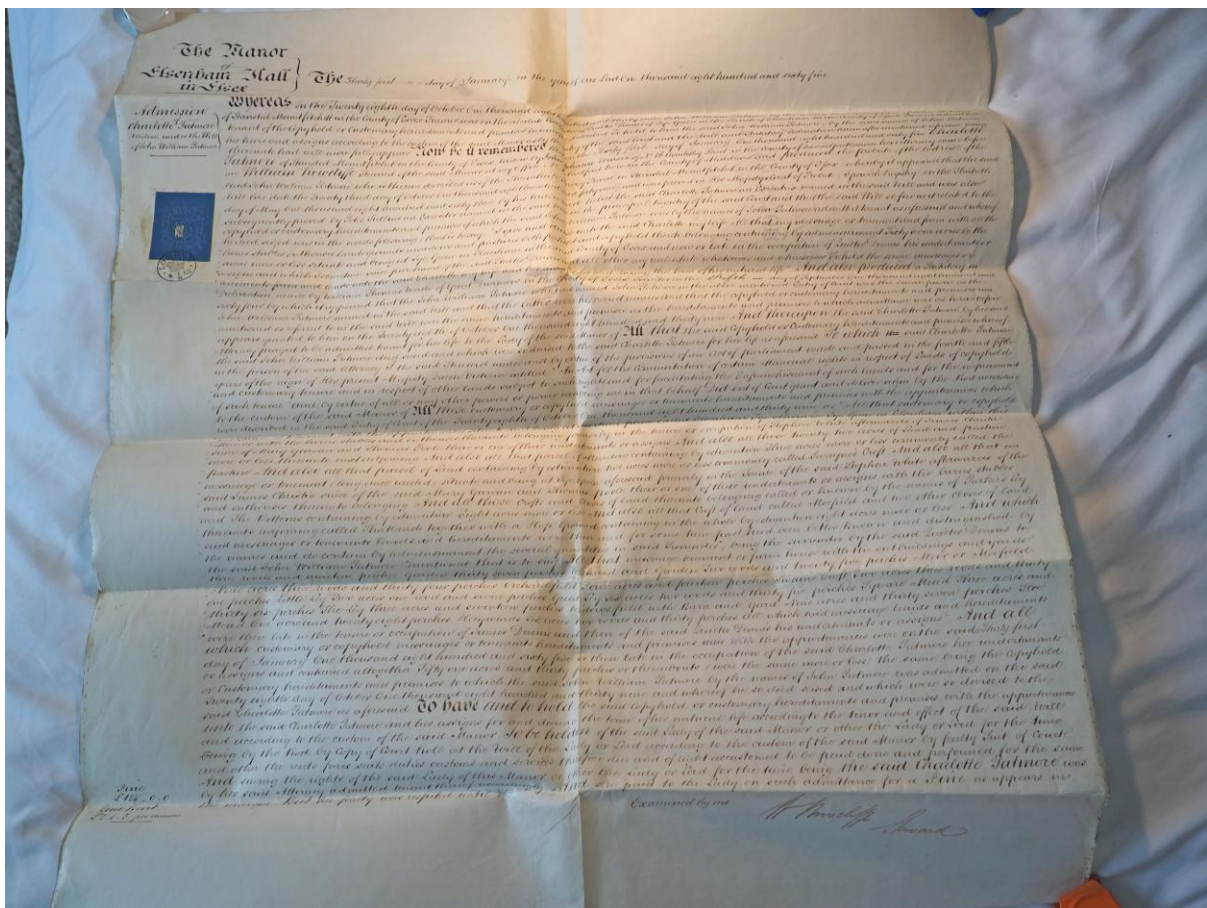
27th October 1860 Conveyance Henry Baker to John Patmore

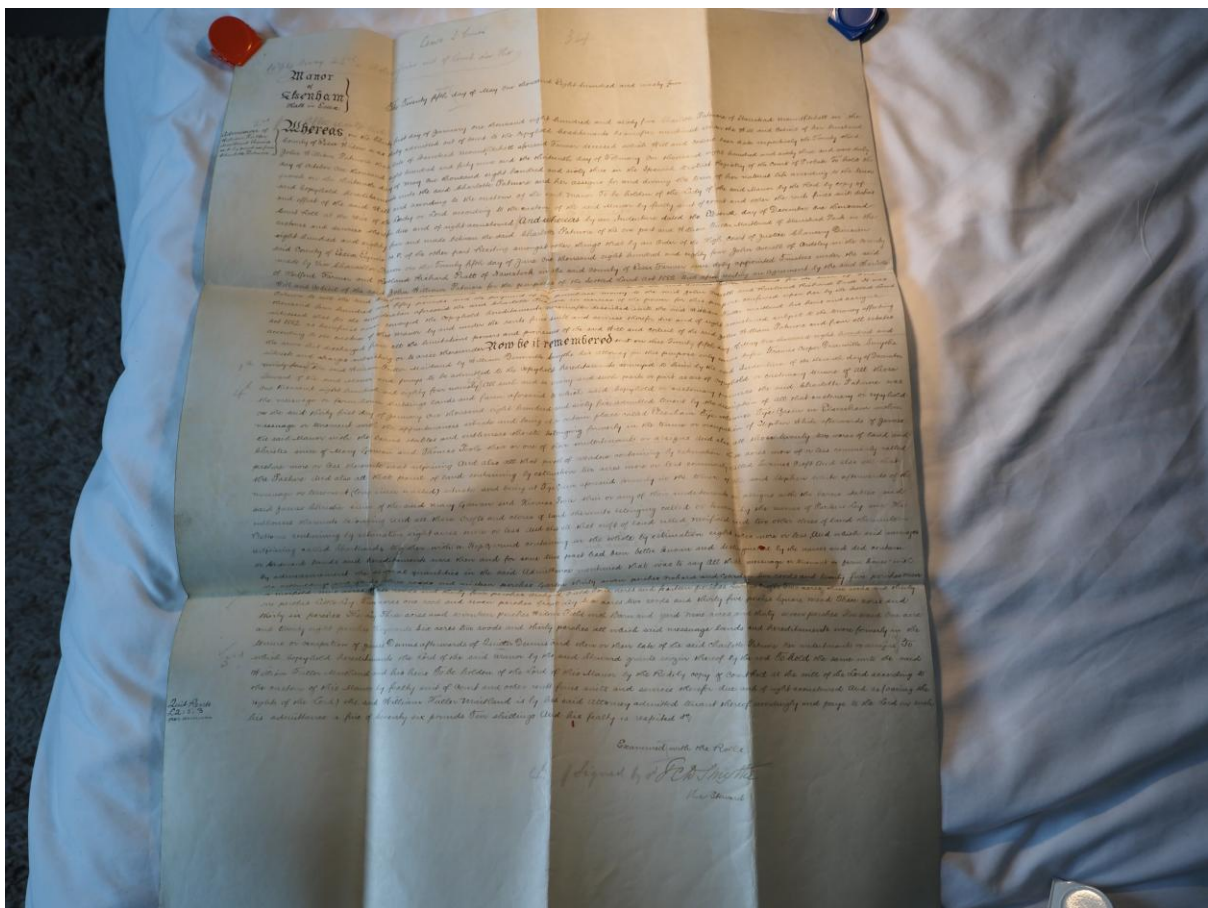
31st January 1865 Copy Admission of Charlotte Patmore Page 1



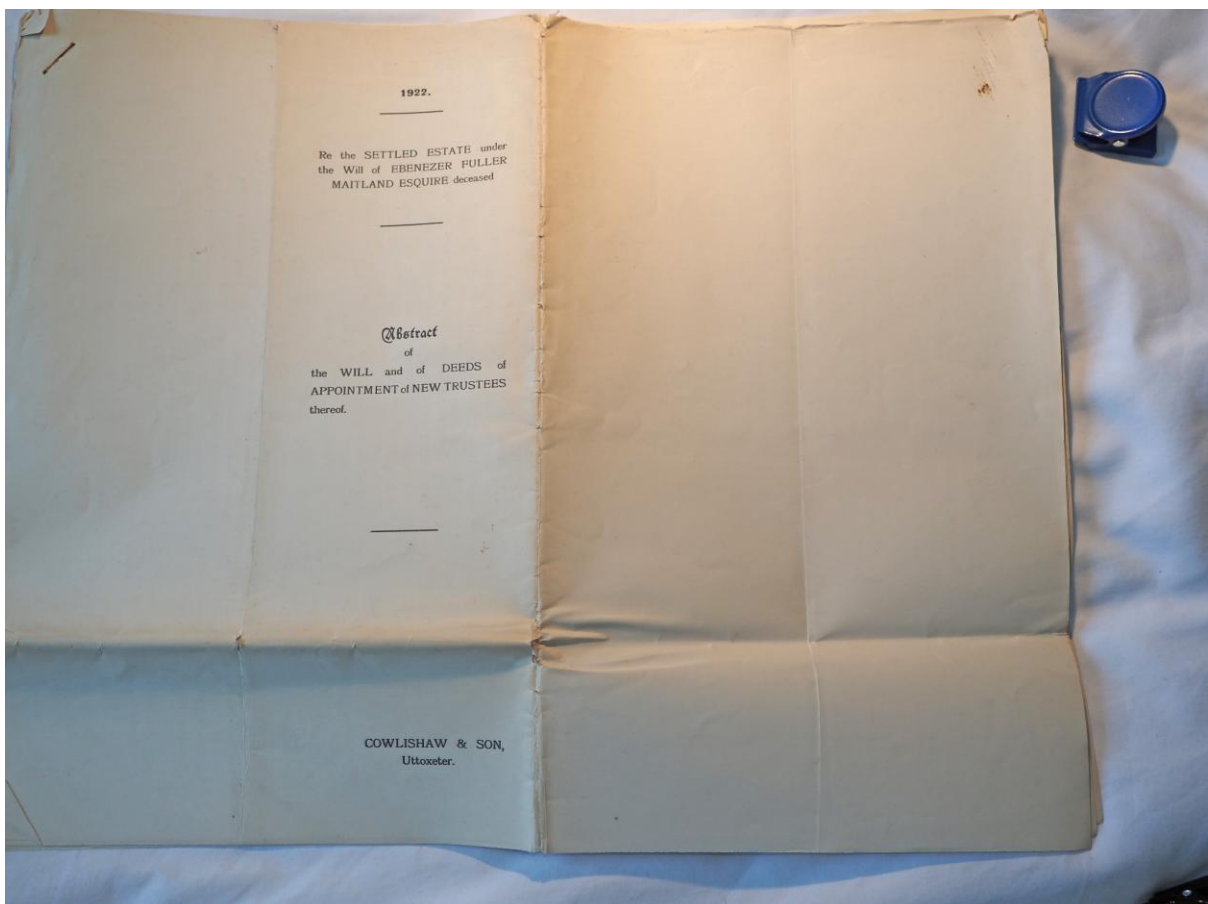
31st January 1865 Copy Admission of land Charlotte Patmore under the will of William Patmore dec'd Page 2



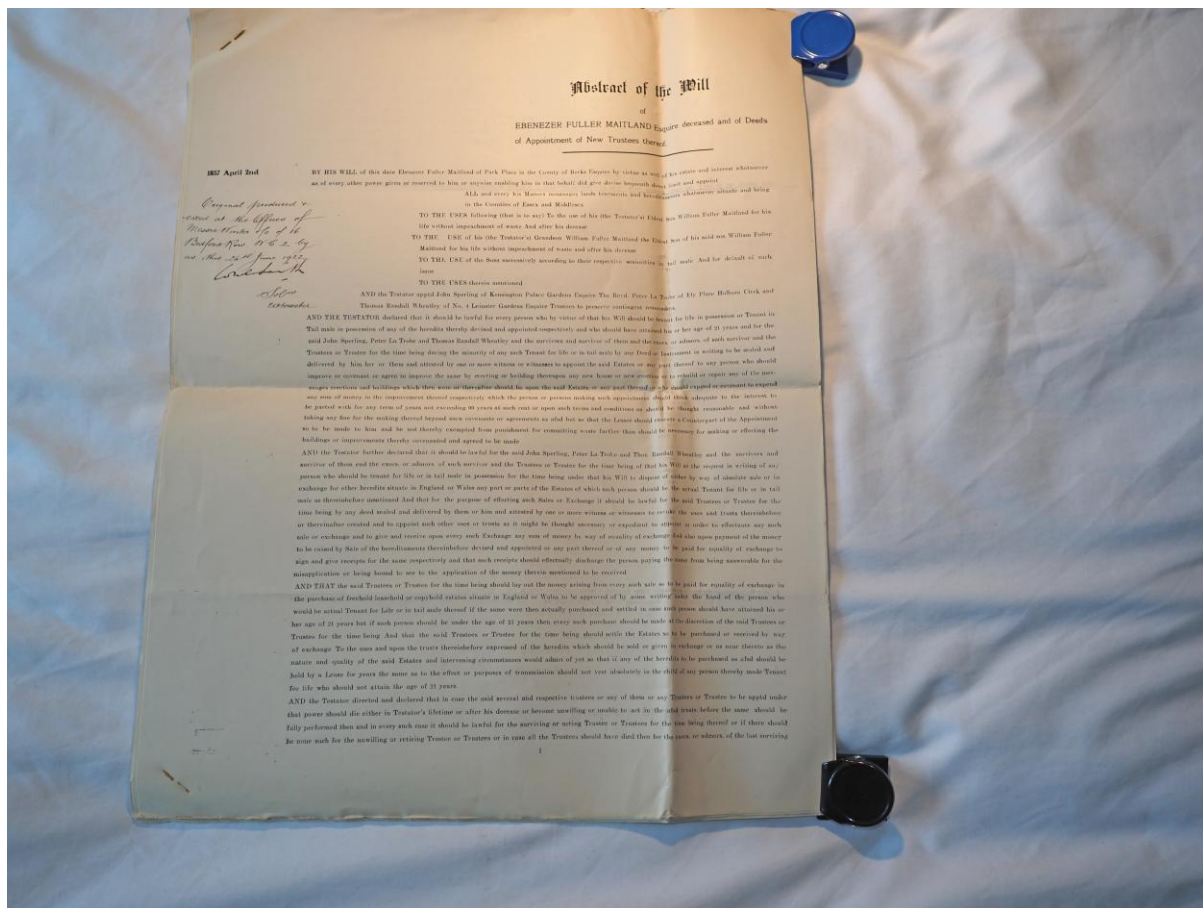
25th May 1894 Admission of William Fuller Maitland to copyhold hereditaments situated in Elsenham Page 1



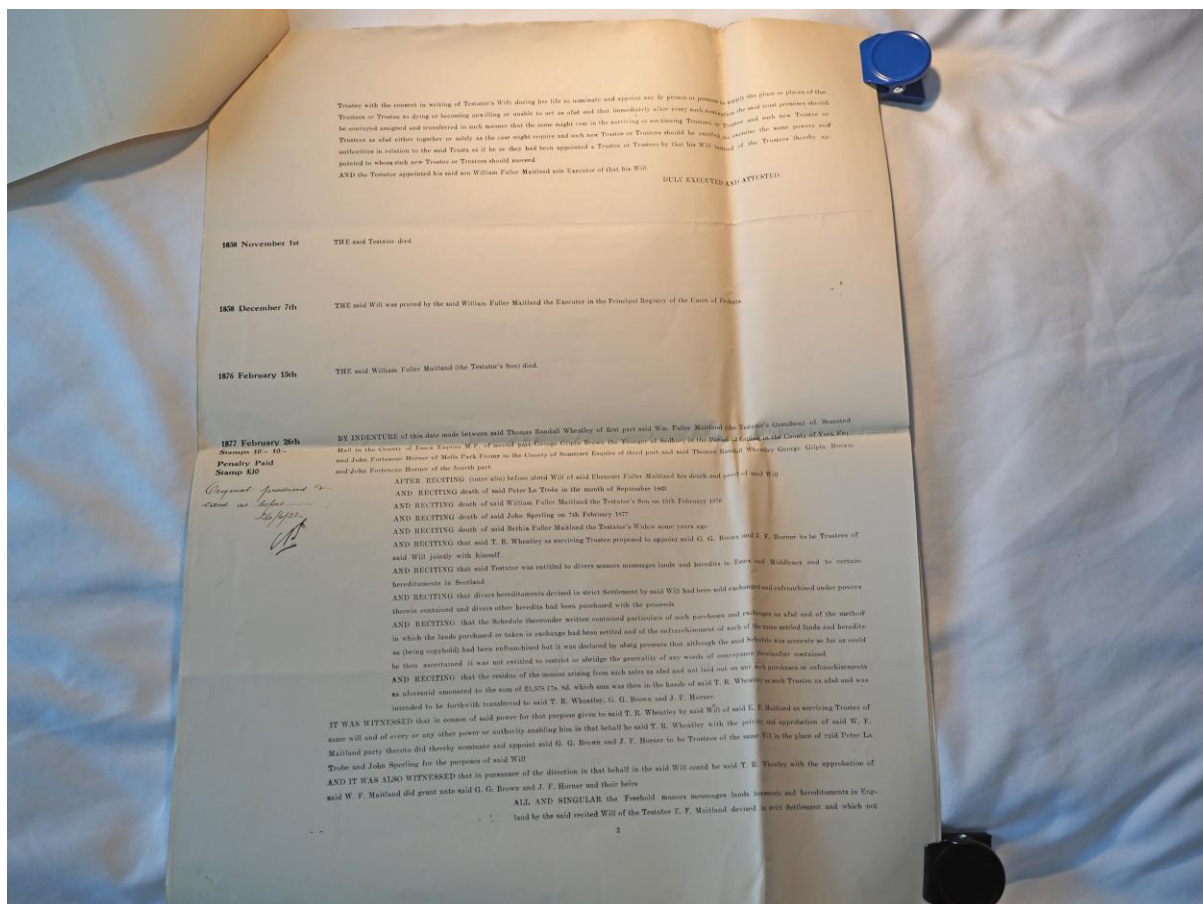
25th May 1894 Admission of William Fuller Maitland to copyhold hereditaments situated in Elnham Page 2



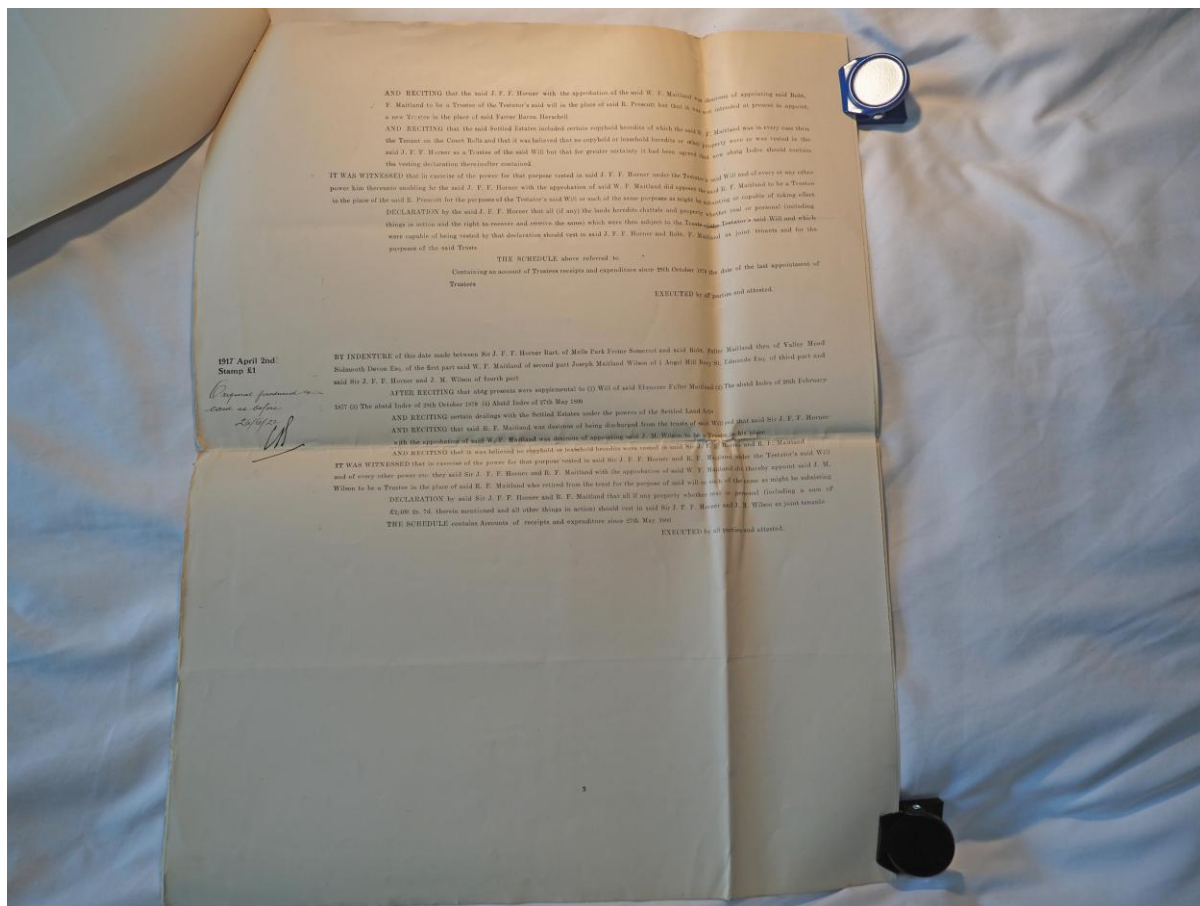
