



Our story of Elsenham's War Dead, "For the Duration" was published on Monday 4 August 2014, to coincide with the anniversary of the start of World War I, priced £8. In addition to the 25 names of those who died commemorated on the Memorial, we also have the stories of a further four men who were born in the village but had moved elsewhere. Also included are the stories of the three men who died in WWII, together with one further casualty from the Troubles in Northern Ireland.

We also have the story of the one woman on the Role of Honour, Sister Edith Aylett of the Queen Alexandra's Imperial Military Nursing Service. She survived the war, died in the village in 1963 and is buried in the High Street Cemetery.
